Dear Parents/Guardians:

Every homeroom has been assigned a day next week to come in. Items belonging to students will have been bagged up and labeled with their names, ready to be picked up. Between 11:30 and 1:30 on your assigned day(s), you will need to come to the school to pick up your students' things to bring home. Staff members will be on hand to assist where needed (please keep 6 feet between people, wear a mask). No one will be entering the school. Anything that you drop off will be delivered to teachers by a staff member. (Preschool Parents: you are receiving a different set of instructions from Mrs. Reitter and Mrs. Formato soon.)

We regret that students will not have the opportunity to say goodbye to their teachers this year but I know you all understand and appreciate how very unpredictable and unusual this year has turned out to be. I know I speak for all of them when I say they wish they could tell their students goodbye and have a great summer.

Summer reading assignments and other summer work packets will be located on teacher webpages during the final days of school and will remain available throughout the summer.

We appreciate your help in getting school property returned and we look forward to seeing you next week (albeit behind a mask).
